## Comments on and questions to the thesis:

Author in his master's thesis demonstrated the ability of theoretical thinking as well as the ability to apply theoretical approaches into research of concrete problems of international practice. He also demonstrated ability to analyze results of scientific researches (both theorethical and applied) and to use them in elaboration of his own theme. Paper deals with very actual global problem, that needs the interdisciplinary approach. Topic is reflected from the perspective of economy especially, the perspective of international relations discipline however is not elaborated. Text is well structured, but I would recommend to give reasons for both logical structure and approach to the problem more in detail. Questions: 1) Explain more deeply the possibilities of world systems theory and its methodology in reflection of migration. 2) Explain the international political context of migration in UK and Poland.

## Conclusion: I recommend the thesis for defence.
