The only thing that I would point out is that the writer is actually co-owner of the start-up under discussion, which in definition gives her a bias. The positive effect of this, is that the thesis does not only provide for an academic result, but the outcomes will also be used in practice. On the down-side, a more objective look could potentially reveil currently unmentioned risks.

Apart from this, the thesis is well written and has a good structure. The above mentioned practical relevance of the thesis is especially remarkable. It is will be of great value to the author and is also and interesting piece of work for a reader.

### 4. Questions for discussion:

I would recommend that for the defense of the thesis there would be questions about feasibility of a managing an enterprise over two countries with seamless operations.

It would be also interesting to ask more questions about extreme scenarios. What would a company of three people do in the optimistic scenario that during the peak season 2013 there are 500 orders placed in one month? More insights on the production capacities and time to upscale would be interesting.
