Comments and Questions:

He formulates conclusions on possible investment opportunities in Vietnam by pointing out areas/industries, which have not been fully developed yet and pose great investment potential. I can say that the thesis is a solid piece of work, the Author applied his theoretical knowledge on practically oriented analysis, the objectives, structure, logic and stylistics are on an acceptable level. The work misses more real-life examples to illustrate the findings, which is a pitty, because there is enough bibliography in this respect. Question: Vietnam and China are both centrally planned economies. Do you see, however, some differences in trade and investment opportunities between these countries in Central and Eastern Europe?
