Spanish economy was one of the economies heavily influenced by the financial crisis in 2008-2009 and the consequent economic crisis in Europe. Among the crush of the housing market and overall economic slowdown, the employment has significantly deteriorated and unemployment rate has reached one of the highest levels in the EU. The on-going economic discussion claims, that economic downturn has merely exposed the long-term structural defects in the Spanish labour market. The thesis has set to uncover those underlying issues by examining the development of key labour market indicators and assessing the outcome of labour market reform implemented in 2012. Subsection 1.2 and 1.3 The complexity of both theoretical and practical content is adequate for the Bachelor level of thesis. Subsection 3.1: The author has chosen to analyse time-series data of key labour market indicators with respect to the individual policies implemented during the 2012 reform. Due to this fact the variety of the indicators is narrowed. As covered in conclusion the prospective extension of the analysis in case of the inclusion of macroeconomic indicators would enhance the overall perspective of the thesis. Albeit this reservation the quality and the depth of the analysis is on the upper limit of the Bachelor theses quality range.

Subsection 3.2: The definition of the thesis objective is in line with the approved assignment. Subsection 3.3: The defined and approved thesis objective has been covered in satisfactory extent.

Subsection 3.4: The theoretical part fully covers general concepts of labour market as well as a brief introduction to the overall state of the Spanish economy.

Subsection 3.5: The analytical part focuses on the analysis of individual policies of labour market reform and their real impact after their implementation.

Subsection 3.6: Conclusions are logically structured with respect to the structure of the thesis and the chosen thesis objective. The main added value is the complex analysis of various segments of the labour market, which present a picture of the real impacts of the reform in more detail than for example the sole analysis of the dynamics of the overall unemployment rate.
