I also appreciate a pretty objective view on given business however it is also evident, that author feels enthusiastic about it in the same time. In case of limitations I would only question elaborating SWOT analysis prior to other analyses which are by definition used in order to conduct a quality SWOT. And secondly I am missing some further job description and expectations from the new employee who is vital for the future of the company as well as his/her remuneration. I may only guess that the salary expenses would reach 90k EUR within next three years.
