The author has dealt, in a very informative and reader friendly way, with the topic of Socially Responsible coffee farming. She has laid out the present situation and has made some very compelling recommendations for improvements in the way that the coffee itself is grown and harvested. Her recommendations call for greater "interaction" between grower (producer) and end consumer; the grower to instigate more sustainable methods at his end of the production process (the agricultural part), while the consumer must understand the necessity of the new methods and be willing to pay extra for the now more sustainable product.
