Overall evaluation and questions to be answered in the course of the defense:

Well organized and written thesis. English level of writing, very specific and up-to-date topic, primary and secondary research produced solely by the student are main positive aspects of the thesis. Primary research is limited due to number of respondent, however this limitation is acceptable as it is extremely rare to find respondents using both SAP and Oracle. The outcomes have practical applicability in areas of market analysis research, comparison of SAP vs Oracle and in SAP implementation recommendations. Research question is answered, though due to sensitive data should be further discussed at the defence. The student fulfilled conditions of final bachelor thesis requirements and I therefore recommend this thesis for defence.
